



## Updates to VTL (Malaysia and Korea) and FEPO (Perth and Brisbane)

Dear Trade Partners

Please note the VTL and FEPO updates below.

### **Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL)**

#### Malaysia

SIN-KUL VTL will continue to be subjected to quota for travel from 21 January 2022 onwards, pending further updates from both Singapore and Malaysia's respective governments.

Note that once quotas are reached, Singapore Airlines flights will be closed for public sales.

For period 21 January 2022 to 06 February 2022 (both dates inclusive), no new bookings allowed for travel on SIN-KUL VTL as quotas have been reached. This does not affect passengers with existing confirmed bookings.

#### Korea

Effective 21 January 2022, SIN-ICN will enjoy quarantine-free travel until further notice.

#### VTL Eligibility Criteria

There is no change to existing VTL or test requirements. Please ensure passengers meet all VTL requirements<sup>1</sup>.

### **Australia's For Eligible Passengers Only (FEPO)**

#### Australia - Brisbane

Singapore Airlines flights from Singapore to Brisbane are now included into the list of FEPO flights effective 22 January 2022. The Queensland Health website<sup>2</sup> will detail the entry requirements when the Public Health Direction is published at 0100 Hrs AEST on 22 January 2022.

#### Australia - Perth

Singapore Airlines will not begin FEPO flights from Singapore to Perth from 05 February
