## Singapore-Vancouver-Seattle Seasonal Services



Singapore Airlines is flying four-times weekly seasonal services to Vancouver (Canada) and Seattle (United States of America), through October 2022.

SIA is operating a 253-seater Airbus A350-900 on the route, with 42 Business Class seats, 24 Premium Economy Class seats and 187 Economy Class seats.

# Vaccinated Travel Lane Flights

Flights designated as Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) services, provide eligible customers quarantine-free entry into Singapore. Customers who fly on a designated VTL service must ensure that they meet all applicable VTL eligibility criteria.

Short-term visitors and Long-Term Pass holders need to apply for a Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP) to board the VTL flights to Singapore, which can be done [online](#).

## Additional Eligibility Requirements:

- To be considered fully vaccinated, you require two shots of an approved vaccine, or one shot of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. The final dose must be completed at least 14 days prior to arrival in Singapore.
- You must provide a vaccination certificate in English. All vaccination certificates must be digitally certifiable (i.e. contains a QR code for verification).
- Accepted vaccination certificates:

**Canada:** The Smart Health Cards (SHC) format on the CommonTrust Network or the Vaccination Credential Initiative are accepted. SHCs can also be digitally verified on the SMART Health Card Verifier app.

### The USA:

1. The [Smart Health Card \(SHC\)](#) format on the CommonTrust Network (CTN) or the [Vaccination Credential Initiative \(VCI\)](#). SHCs can also be digitally verified on the [SMART Health Card Verifier app](#).

2. A physical vaccination record and a letter signed by the state, local health authority, or vaccination provider attesting to the travellers vaccination status will also be accepted. This letter must contain the traveller's name and one other personal identifier, such as the date of birth or passport number; as well as the date and name of the vaccine administered.

3. Digital vaccination record retrieved from the public health database of the state or the local health authority.

Please note that short-term visitors and Long-Term Pass holders showing proof of vaccination via 1 or 3 must submit these documents [here](#).

- A professionally administered Antigen Rapid Test (ART) or PCR test within two days of the VTL flight departure with a negative result.
- Pre-book and pay for your on-arrival test [here](#)
  - You must self-isolate until test results are available, usually available within 24 hours.
- Post- arrival Covid-19 Antigen Rapid Tests (ART) procedures and requirements:
  - Self-administered ART tests are required from Days 2 to 7 post arrival.
  - For Days, 2, 4, 5 and 6, you are required to self-administer an ART at your place of accommodation and upload the test results online.
  - For Days 3 and 7, you are required to undergo a supervised self-administered ART.
- Short-term visitors must purchase travel insurance, with a minimum coverage of S\$30,000 for Covid-19-related medical treatment and hospitalisation costs, prior to travel to Singapore.
- All visitors must use the [TraceTogether app](#) in Singapore to facilitate contact tracing. After leaving Singapore, the TraceTogether app data must be kept for 21 days.

## A clean cabin for everyone

### Sanitized cabin environment

Before every flight, the aircraft is thoroughly cleaned. Commonly-touched surfaces are disinfected. Lavatories are cleaned with high-strength disinfectants and cabin surfaces are treated with a long-lasting antimicrobial coating.



### Filtered, clean air

Every aircraft in the Singapore Airlines Group fleet is equipped with High-Efficiency Particulate Air (HEPA) filters, which remove more than 99.9% of the microbes in the air. Cabin air is also refreshed every two to three minutes throughout the flight.



### Food safety and hygiene standards

In preparing your inflight meals, our catering partners uphold the highest hygiene standards including personal protective equipment for food handlers and using automation to reduce contact. Do note that meal services may be simplified on certain flights to meet regulatory requirements.
